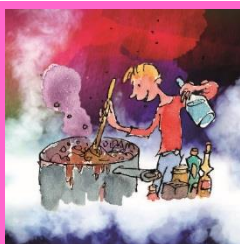
Literacy:

Topic:

Our Topic theme this half term is:
What's on the menu

We will be looking at:

Where different foods come from, which foods are grown locally? How we could grow food in the classroom?

In Science we are investigating: Healthy and unhealthy foods, why is a balanced diet important? How do fruit and vegetables grow?



RE:

In RE we will be discussing and answering the question: Do people need to go to church to show that they are Christian?

We will discuss what favourite and special places children have outside of school, why these places are special for them and what a church is, what other buildings are special for other religious groups.
