Literacy:

We will be using traditional tales to practice sequencing, acting and drawing story maps. As well as looking at non-fiction books and writing labels, lists and captions.

Lastly, we will be practising our cursive writing and phonics daily.

Please help by:

listening to your child read at home and enjoying stories together.

Numeracy:

- Form numbers correctly
- Order numbers from 0 to 100.
- Place value: Counting, recognising and writing numbers from 1 to 100.
- Addition and Subtraction: Identify one more or one less.
- Review 2D shapes and learn about 3D shapes: Naming and describing these shapes.

Please help by:

Recognising numbers and shapes around the environment. Play shop keepers to find one more or one less. Use objects to practise counting, adding and subtracting. Maybe counting how many sausages or carrots they have with their dinner!

Topic:

Our Topic theme this half term is: 'All Around The World'

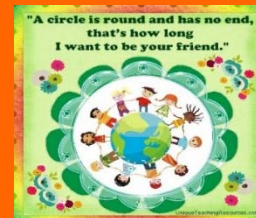
We will be looking at different countries, their capitals and where they are located on a map. The children will be identifying different animals, plants and trees. We will discuss our senses and body parts.
