





Literacy:

Stories being read this half term:
Charlie and the Chocolate Factory



The children will learn how to write a fantasy story, and will learn to identify and use a variety of nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs and similes in their work.

We will also practise using inverted commas, exclamation marks and question marks.

Numeracy:

In Year 3 the children will look at: number bonds to 10 and 100, addition and subtraction, use place value to understand units, tens and hundreds, find 10 or 100 more or less than a number, read and write numbers to 1000, column addition and learn to solve word problems.

In Year 4 the children will be looking at Roman Numerals, rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, recognising place value, comparing and ordering numbers, counting in 25s.

Times tables will include: 1,2,3,4, 5 and 8.
Recall multiplication and division fact.

Topic:

Our Topic theme this half term is:
Chocolate

We will be tasting different chocolates, and finding out where chocolate comes from, what factors affect its growth, who first discovered and used it, how it came to be eaten in Europe.



RE:

In RE we will be discussing Hinduism, and we will explore the question: Would celebrating Diwali at home and in the community bring a sense of belonging to Hindus?
