



Year 7 Catch up Funding Statement 2017-2018

The Government provides every secondary school in the country with additional funding to support the progress of pupils entering school who achieve below the national average score of 100 in English and Maths assessments at Key Stage 2. Schools are provided with financial support to try and help this group of pupils catch up with the national average.

Last Year Parkfield received £2,571. This was spent on the following:

Additional Staff in English and Maths Lessons: Two HLSAs provided Maths and English targeted catch up work with 9 students	£2,571

The impact of the spending was as follows (Until Summer 17):

Subject	Expected Progress (%)
English	72%
Maths	66%

Progress measured against FFT top 20% predicted grades in English Language and Maths and assessment results at the end of year 7. Expected progress is two grades of progress to help close the gap from teacher assessments.

This is based on a cohort of 9 pupils from an initial intake of 14 pupils.
