Numeracy:

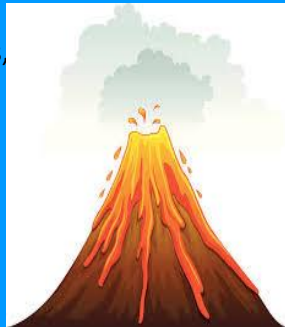
