

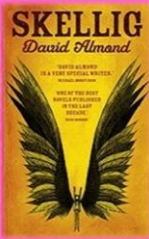

### Numeracy:

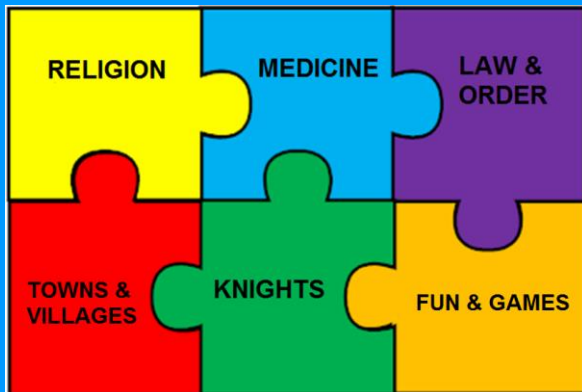
Ask your child to show you how to convert a fraction to a decimal and percentage!

This half term studies will include:

- ❖ Converting between different units of metric measure and using + - x ÷ to solve problems involving measure.
- ❖ Estimating and comparing acute, obtuse and reflex angles, identify angles at a point on a straight line, and drawing given angles and measuring them in degrees.
